Handovers occur at multiple points within the healthcare delivery system. Preparation is critical to effective handover.

- Identification
- S Situation
- B Background
- Assessment
- Recommendation/ Read back/Risk

Your goal – and your responsibility – is to be prepared

Making conversations easier





I-S-B-A-R-R-R

Have all the information you will need right at your fingertips. ISBAR3 will help you with sharing concise and important information in a short amount of time. It limits jargon, keeps the message clear, and removes the influence of hierarchy and personality.

- Identification
 - You, Your role, Recipient of Handover information. Patient
- Situation Brief summary of patient's current status. What is happening?
- **Background** What is the clinical background/context?
- Assessment What do you think the problem is?
- Recommendation/Read-back/Risk What do you recommend? Check back for shared understanding. Assign and accept responsibility/accountability. Identify any risks.
